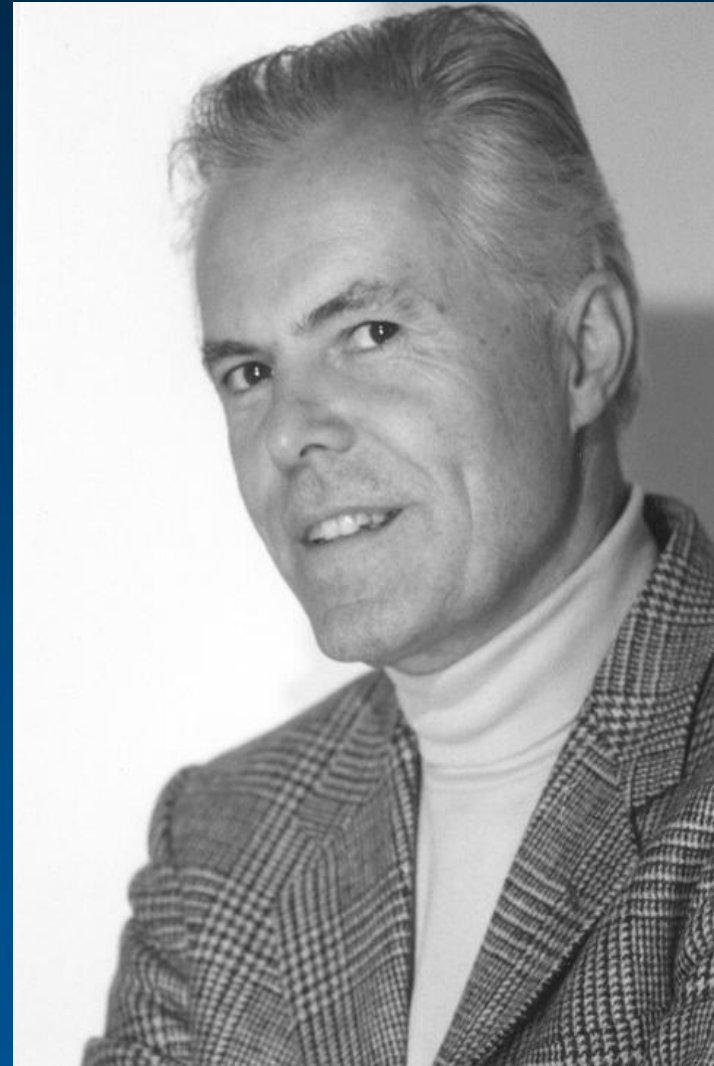
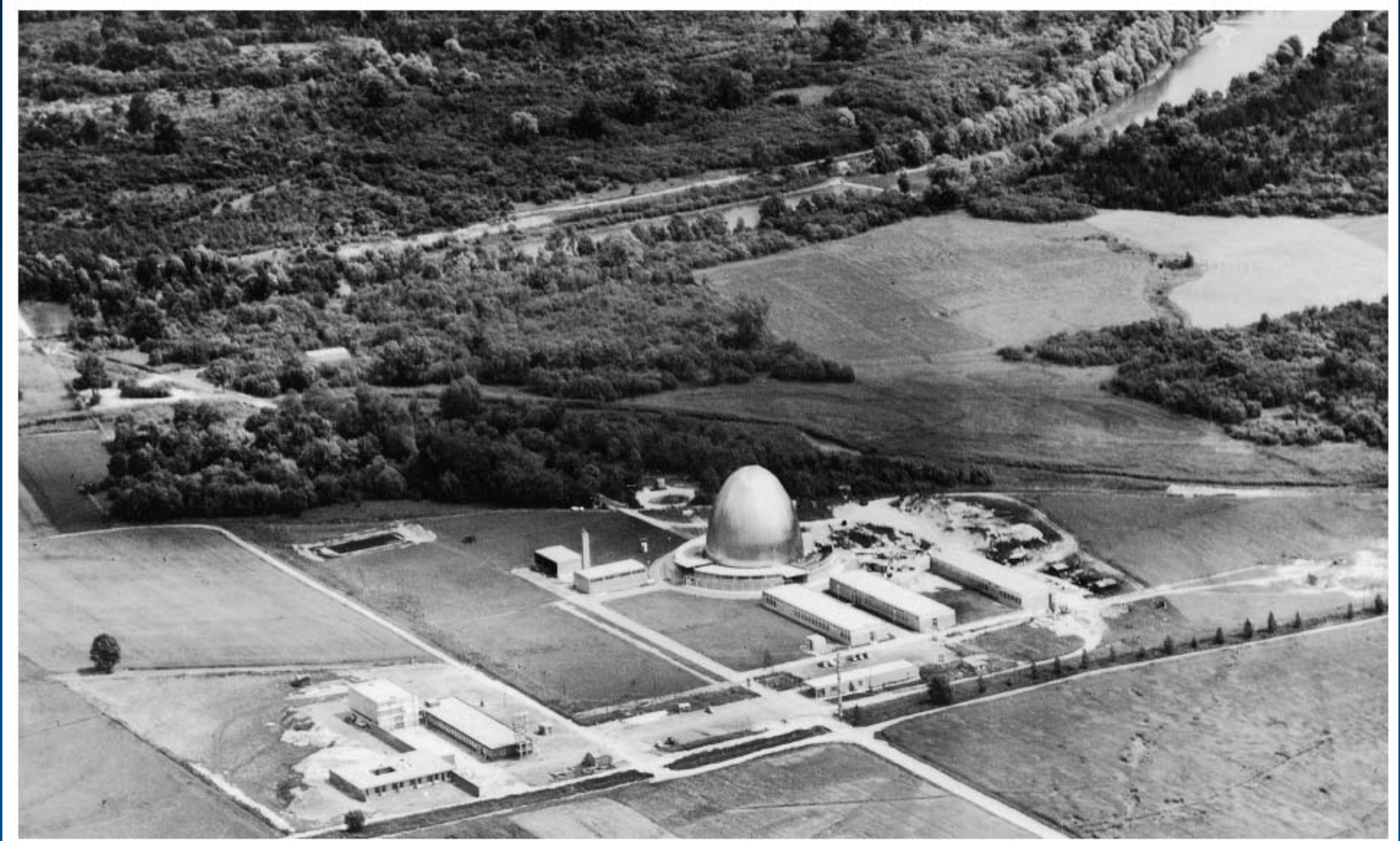

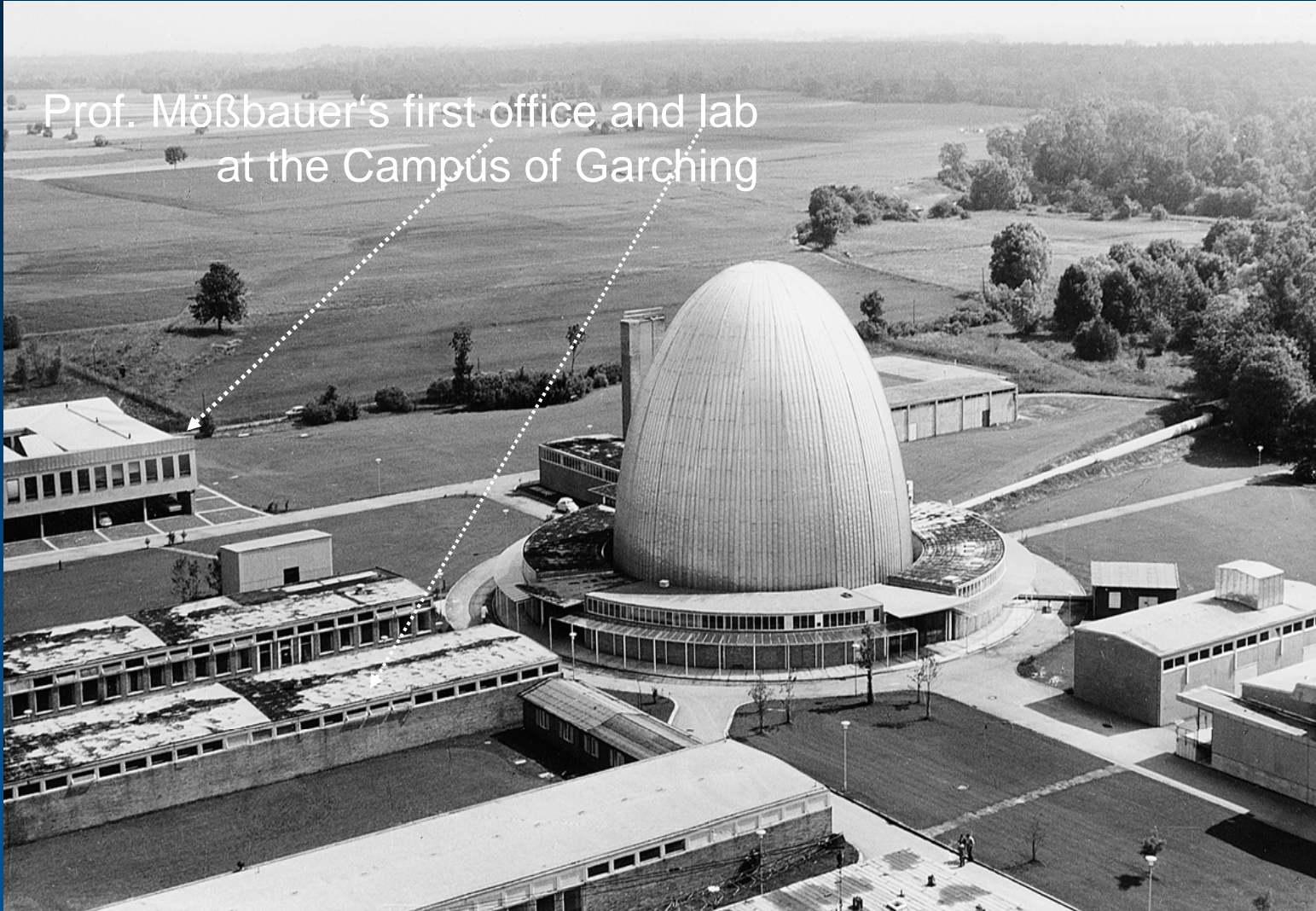




Campus Garching 1957 showing the Forschungsreaktor Munich I, also called “Atomei”



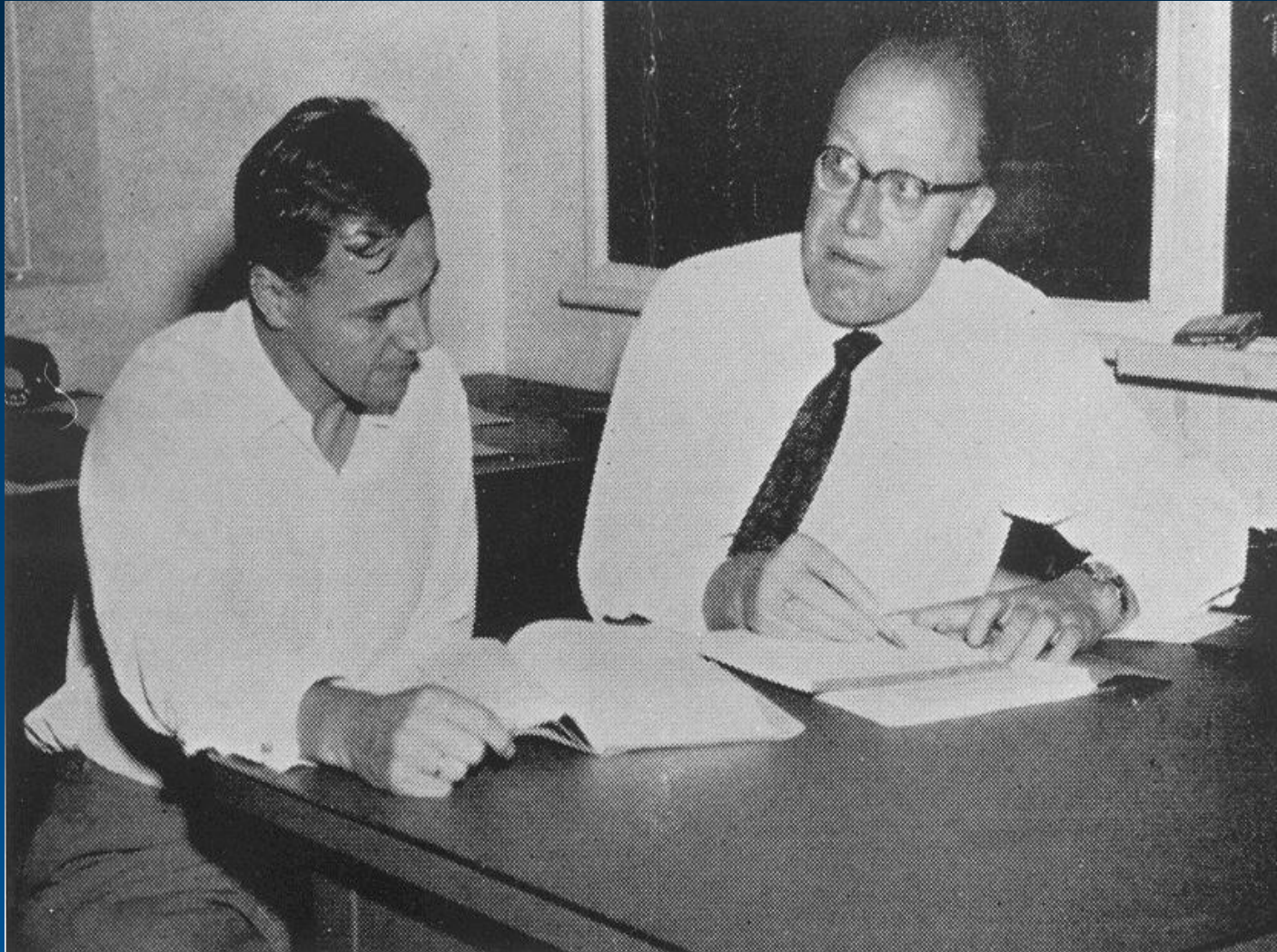

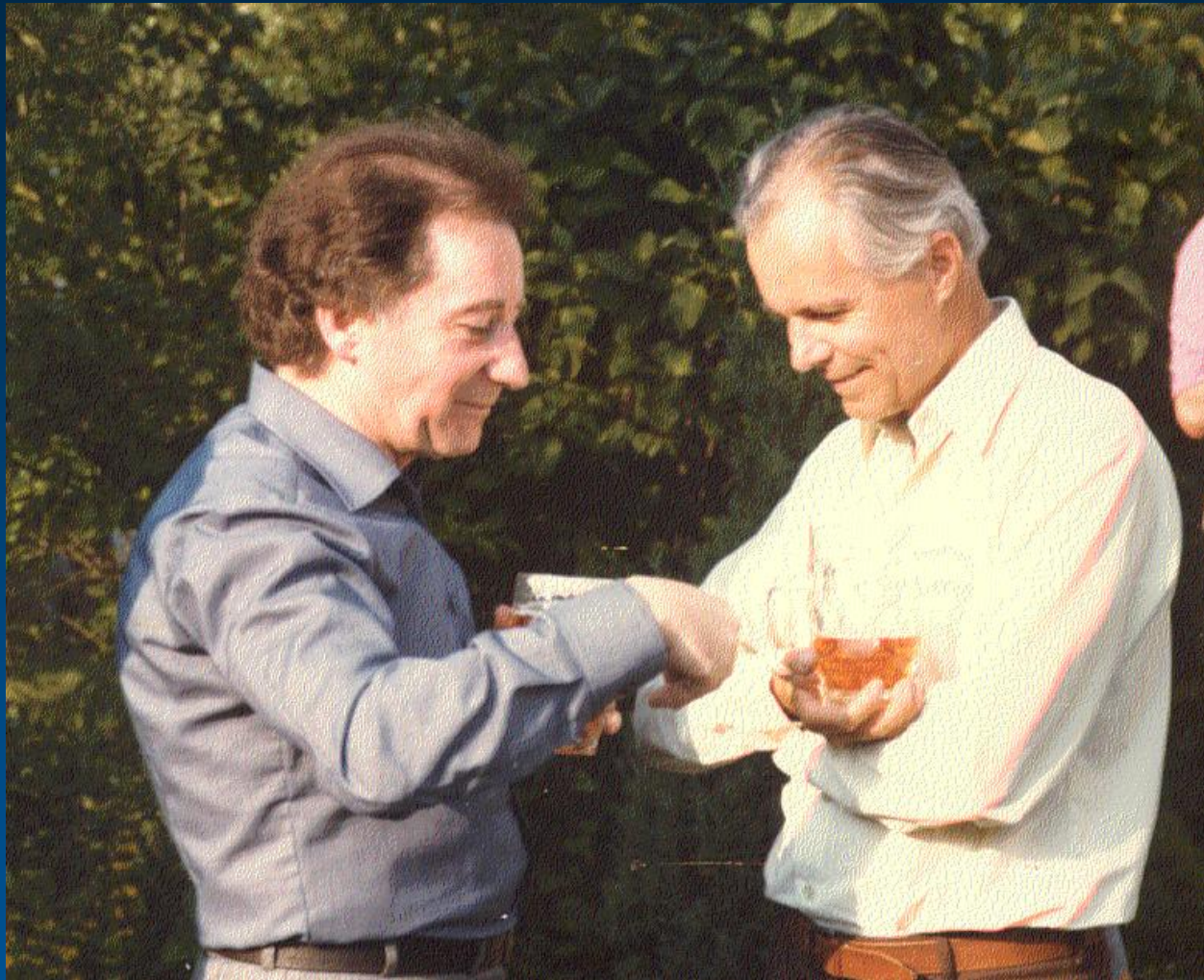

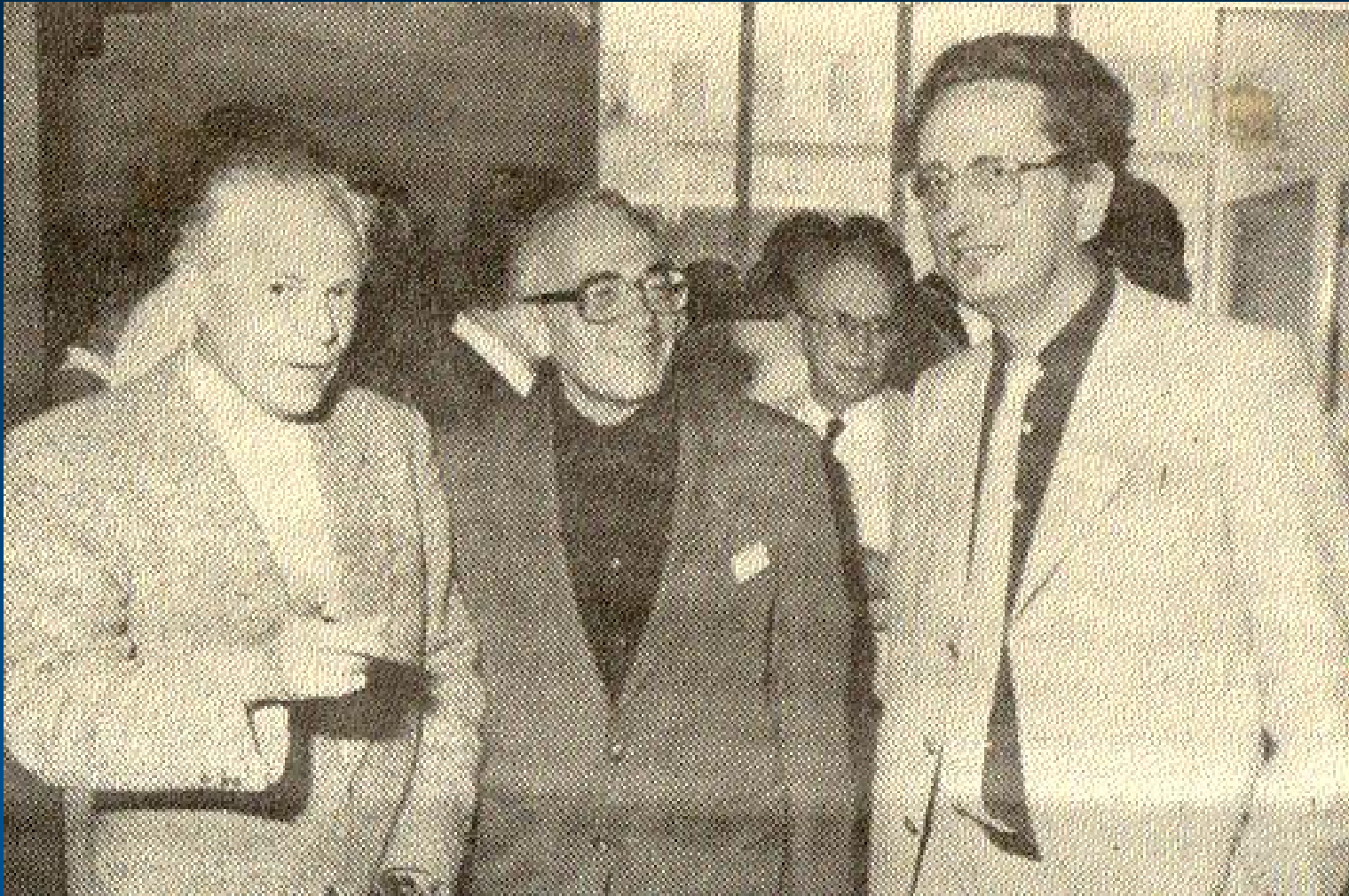
